



BYF Volunteer Opportunities

Coaches:

Head Coaches are expected to attend all BYF monthly meetings, practices, games, clinics and events. You are expected to follow the league program and protocol for drills, plays and practices. You are also expected to keep weekly communication between your coaching staff and your player's parents.

Asst. Coaches are expected to attend all practices, games, clinics and events (meetings are optional but recommended). You are expected to follow the league program and protocol for drills, plays and practices.

Helper Coaches are encouraged to help at and attend any and all practices and games that your schedule allows and try to remain a consistent presence with your team and coaching staff. You are also expected to follow the league program and protocol for drills, plays and practices.

Game Day Crew (chains):

Every game requires a crew of three individuals to hold down markers and chains. We would ask that each grade provide 2 teams of three to work a game.

Equipment Turn-in / Jamboree:

After the last games at the end of the season, we need 4 individuals from each grade to assist with returning equipment to their racks and bins in the equipment trailer. We also need 2-3 additional people to help with serving pizza and other items that day.

Trailer Manager / Organizers:

We have 2 equipment trailers that need frequent organizing to keep gear in their proper place. There is also a file cabinet with copies of paperwork that need to be kept clean and organized. If you have a knack for organization we can use your help. Admin may not be at every practice so if there was a full-time trailer manager you would be provided a set of keys in the event of admin. absences.
